November 2014




About the research

- The survey took place in October and November 2014
- It was promoted online via the MS International Federation's website, e-newsletters, social media and membership
- It used the online survey tool SurveyMonkey
- 1,948 people from 70 countries responded
- 40 per cent were from the USA
- 12 per cent were from Australia
- 10 per cent were from the UK










Q4 What type of MS do you have?








Q5 How long have you been living with MS?








Q6 Do you think your MS has changed as you have gotten older?



Q7 What are your THREE main concerns about ageing, related to MS?










Q9 How prepared do you feel for getting older with MS, where 1 = "not at all" and 5 = "very prepared"?



Q10 Have you considered writing a will or making advanced directives for what happens if you become unwell?



Q11 Have you budgeted financially for older age?


Answered: 1,938 Skipped: 10
