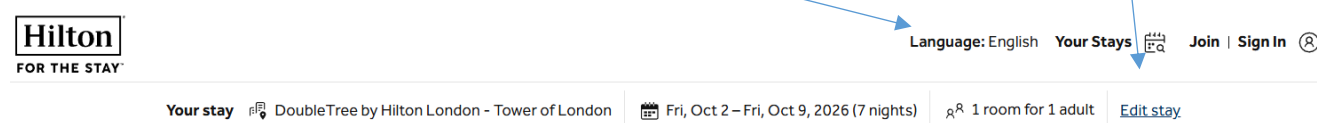
### 2.1 To book your room at the DoubleTree by Hilton Tower of London

- **Tower Hill** on the Circle/District line is the closed underground station and direct **from St Pancras International** train station.
